Prohibit Partisan Rescissions

Dear Minority Leader Schumer:

We, the undersigned organizations, urge you to ensure that the upcoming appropriations legislation prohibits partisan rescissions under the Impoundment Control Act. Congressional Republicans have made it clear that even if Congress were to pass a continuing resolution to maintain current funding levels, they would later use the backdoor rescissions process to cut key programs on a partisan basis. This threatens to eliminate our communities' access to public education, basic healthcare, clean water, safe food, and fair, affordable housing.

We've already seen the Trump administration illegally withhold Congressionally-provided bipartisan funding intended for critical programs. The Trump administration is intent on eliminating more funding via the partisan rescission process — cuts that are harming the everyday lives of tens of millions of residents.

This is your one opportunity to protect critical programs. Senator Merkley has offered an amendment that would protect against those partisan rescissions in the FY2026 appropriations bills. You must ensure that any appropriations legislation includes this language. Unlike the partisan rescissions under the Impoundment Control Act, the appropriations bill requires your support.

The impact of these rescissions falls on every American family and is most felt by underserved communities including Black communities. We urge you to leverage your power and withhold your support of any appropriations bill that fails to protect the provided funding from rescissions under the Impoundment Control Act.
