

**Resolution # 2011-6-21
Regarding Hydraulic Fracturing**

On a motion made by Canny MacGonagle and seconded by Rick Ege, the following resolution was proposed and read:

WHEREAS, there are concerns about the potential negative effect on water quality and quantity which may result from hydraulic fracturing for natural gas extraction,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Musconetcong River Management Council opposes any such activities that will adversely affect the quality of life in the Delaware River Basin and neighboring watersheds.

With a total of eleven yes votes, zero no votes and no abstentions, the motion carried and the resolution was adopted.
